MEETING OF SEPTEMBER 23, 2024

Mayor Pro Tem Dennis Hinds called the meeting to order. Councilmembers Bezdicek, Blumenshein, Hamshar, and Smick, Public Works Steve Gibson, Community member David White, and the Town clerk attended the meeting. Arriving late was Dimitar Andreeva.

The September 9, 2024 meeting minutes were read and approved as read.

The payables were presented to the Council for their review and discussion. The payables were moved by Bezdicek and seconded by Smick —a motion carried by a vote of the Council.

Building plans for D. White were discussed. Mr. White showed the council an email from Wyatt Arlynn, Environmental Health Technician for Whitman County Public Health states "At this time, our office does not have any concerns regarding the 100' sanitary control area of the well". The council agreed to move forward with the building permit. It is up to the Whites to abide by all the rules and regulations associated with the well and reservoir with a motion from Bezdicek and seconded by Hamshar.

D. Andreeva expressed concerns with the chickens at 102 E Nob Hill. The smell and the noise from the chickens is his main complaint. He also brought a drawing for a new enclosure for his front door. This enclosure would be within the 20-foot setback. The council will need to do some research on the size and location of Main Street as this is one of the widest streets in town. Many of the buildings are already within the setback. When the council has more information they will revisit the "extension" plan.

The council talked about properties around town that needed cleanup. These properties have been contacted a few times already. The council agreed to have the Town attorney send letters.

No request for additional comments was stated. It was moved by Mayor Pro Tem Hinds, seconded, and unanimously agreed to adjourn. The Meeting was adjourned at 7:45 PM.
